Subject: 23rd Avenue Infrastructure Rehabilitation – Start of Phase II

Dear Resident:

The second phase of infrastructure rehabilitation along 23rd Avenue will begin in mid-July 2019. During the week of July 15, a temporary line will be installed to supply drinking water to homes between du Sommet and Boulevard Don-Quichotte. At the same time, work will begin on clearing the public right-of-way of trees, hedges, fences and other obstacles.

On August 5, the contractor will undertake work to replace the aqueduct, widen the street, rebuild the street infrastructure and drainage, create a pedestrian/bike path and pave the street. The work, which will have a significant impact on traffic, is expected to take about 12 weeks, although the duration could vary depending on contingencies and/or weather.

The work may change the configuration of driveways for some residents. If this applies to you, please contact the Urban Planning and Environment Department at 514 453-1751, ext. 252, to check the bylaws applying to your driveway. During the week of July 8, City employees will be canvassing 23rd Avenue to meet with citizens whose property encroaches on the City's right-of-way and would interfere with the work.

N.B.: To facilitate waste collection, please write your address on all your waste collection bins. If the truck is unable to reach your home, the contractor will be responsible for taking them to a collection point and bringing them back to you in the evening.
