## **A new snow removal procedure for the City of L'Île-Perrot**

L'Île-Perrot, January 31, 2018 – Given the significant snowfall since the beginning of winter, the Public Works Department of the City of L'Île-Perrot will implement a new snow removal procedure. From now on, wherever possible, employees will blow snow at the sides onto private lots along the existing municipal right-of-way. This procedure will widen streets and enhance the safety of motorists.

The operation will be carried out during the day, during normal working hours between 7:00 AM and 4:00 PM, and may be spread over a period of 2 to 3 weeks, taking into account climatic conditions that may have an adverse effect.

For maximum benefits from this exceptional snow removal operation, the City of L'Île-Perrot is counting on residents' cooperation in refraining from parking on the street and taking care to properly place waste bins in their private entry inside the property line.

The City also wishes to give a reminder that, until April 1, 2018, overnight street parking is prohibited if not decided otherwise. The message is updated each day at 5:00 PM and states whether night street parking is permitted or prohibited.
