**Subject: Infrastructure rehabilitation work on 23rd Avenue
Start of first phase**

Dear Sir/Madam,

The City hereby informs you that rehabilitation work will start on 23rd Avenue on May 6th, 2019. Work will be divided into two phases, as mentioned at the meeting held on March 4th.

The first phase of work will include the cladding of the 300-mm-diameter sanitary sewer pipe between Boulevard Don-Quichotte and Boulevard Perrot. Work on the structural lining of the water pipe (cladding) will be completed between rue du Sommet and boulevard Perrot. We will also take the opportunity to replace the fire hydrants. The work will take place mainly from Monday to Friday between 7:00 AM and 6:00 PM over a period of 8 to 12 weeks.

The contractor commissioned by the City will install a temporary water line to supply each of the residences affected by the work. The City wishes to reassure residents that throughout the project, water will be drinkable and of good quality.

The impact on traffic will be minimal during the first phase of work. However, only local traffic will be permitted on 23rd Avenue.
